RULES

All boats must start and finish in Lyme Regis Harbour. This competition is open to charter and privately owned boats

Signing in begins at 08.00, finishes at 08.45 – Signing in takes place on Victoria Pier

Boats leave at 09.00 – all boats must return to the harbour by 17.00 hrs.

Weigh in takes place at the Power Boat Club from 17.30 where the presentations will take place.

Each individual may only weigh in one fish

Individual entry fee of £10 - when you sign in you must name the boat you are on.

Only Black Bream in excess of 24 cms. to be weighed in

One rod per individual – maximum three hooks.

Would boat skippers please advise the organisers if it is their intention to take part and if they have any spare places available.

Competition area – maximum 15 miles radius out of Lyme Regis. NFSA Area “D”

Fishing tackle suppliers to donate prizes that will be given to the 1st prize winners of the individual and boat competition.
